

NAMI: Recognizing the Dignity of Every Person

Have you heard the joke, if you ever want to make God laugh just tell him your plans? I always remember that joke when my life plans don't go the way I expect. Life is full of unexpected surprises, challenges, and unexpected suffering. In these moments we need to be reminded we are not alone and there is nothing that can separate us from the love of God. There are many who struggle silently with mental health issues, in fact one in five adults suffer from some mental illness. As disciples of Christ we are called by Jesus to recognize those who are suffering in our midst and to accompany them on their journey. St. Pope John Paul II once said, "Whoever suffers from mental illness 'always' bears God's image and likeness in himself, as does every human being. In addition, he 'always' has the inalienable right not only to be considered as an image of God and therefore as a person, but also to be treated as such." This message speaks to a core value we have here at St. Patrick, to treat everyone fairly with dignity and respect.

In our society, those with mental illness are often stigmatized, ostracized and alone. The suffering endured by mentally ill persons is a difficult cross to bear, as is the sense of powerlessness felt by their families and loved ones. To reduce the negative stigma and help those in need, St. Patrick is proud to partner with great organizations such as the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) to support

those struggling with mental illness. At St. Patrick, NAMI offers a free, confidential and safe place, open to any family members, partners and friends of individuals with a mental illness to support each other. You do not need to suffer in silence. If you would like to be a part of NAMI Family Support Group you can contact I.boman@namivalleyofthesun.org.

With the group expanding, NAMI is also currently looking for volunteers to help lead family support groups here at St. Patrick. Training is provided, all that is required is a lived experience supporting a loved one with a mental condition. Please consider giving your time to support such an important group and learn how to accompany those in need. Together we can envision and work towards a world where all people affected by mental illness live healthy, fulfilling lives supported by a community that cares. Consider how Christ might be calling you to recognize and accompany others on their journey.
