Merry Christmas!

This year has been a difficult year to say the least. But in the midst of fear and uncertainty, on Christmas day we are reminded of the message of the angel Gabriel to Mary: do not be afraid. Placing her trust in God, Mary responds by saying, "may it be done to me according to your word." How many of us have the faith and trust to respond in a similar way? From the very beginning of her life Mary was chosen by God to participate in the salvation of mankind. Just like us she had free will, she had a choice. On behalf of the entire staff of St. Patrick, I would like to wish you and your family a very Merry Christmas.

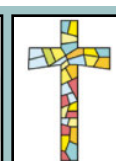

- Finally, it helps formulate a plan that allows men to overcome these obstacles.



