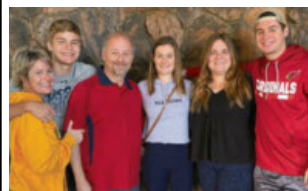

Parents are the foundation of the family and they are also the first preachers of the Gospel to their family. Pope Francis continually talks about the importance of the family in the Church. 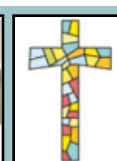

Stewardship

Jesus, your servant Paul says we walk by faith and not by sight. Sometimes this is difficult for me, and I believe only what I can know through the senses. Grant me the grace I need to be courageous enough to do only what is pleasing to the Father. Grant this so that when I struggle to see the work being done in my soul, I may not doubt your perfect plan. Amen.

It has been said that good things come to those who wait, and while this is certainly true, and patience is the fruit of virtue, it's also important to act in response to prayer and God's grace. Sometimes we fail to act not out of patience, but out of fear.

This week's readings speak to seasons, time, and God's providence. Using agricultural and biological metaphors, God demonstrates how the trees grow over time. Every tree, every branch, every spot of shade, and each piece of fruit is created and known by God, as we learn in this week's first reading from Ezekiel. However, his designs take time to unfold, as nothing happens overnight. The trees take seasons to produce fruit and years to offer shade.

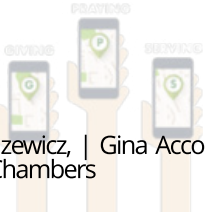
As the gospel affirms, even the smallest seed can grow in due time into a powerful plant. Over time, we (the seed) must respond to the grace (water, sun, and soil) of God. Responding to God in prayer and action is the mark of the Christian's servant heart. For, as St. Paul echoes in the second reading, "we aspire to please him." We will be judged for not only what we said or thought but also what we did in the body, whether good or evil."

Our lives bear fruit. Whether it is good or bad is determined by what, or whom, we draw our life from and how we respond to the source of all life.

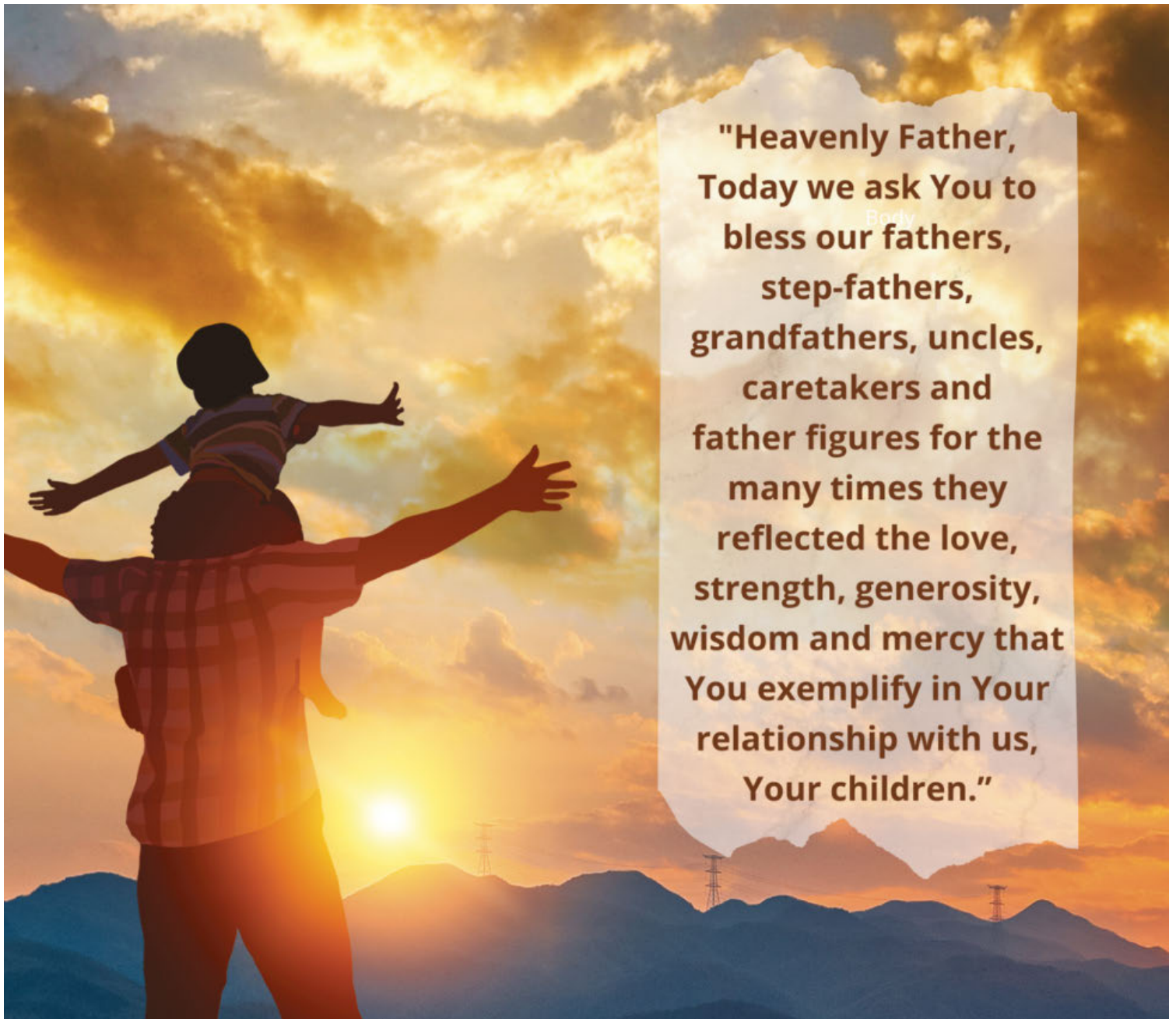

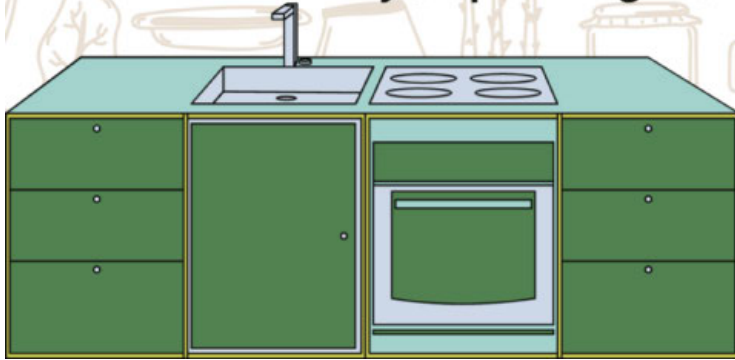
