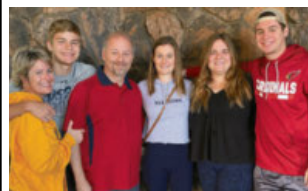

Our Sunday Children's Ministries have had a successful opening this fall season. I want to acknowledge the number of parishioners who heard the call to serve in our nursery for the Sunday morning Masses. Your willingness to respond to an important need in our community is a great witness of service. I so appreciate the effort of many parishioners sharing the outreach on different Sundays so the work is spread over many people. The need is always there so we will be inviting more parishioners to give of their time in serving in the nursery.

Our Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW) and Young Disciples are offered at Sunday morning Masses. Children up to 4th grade are sent forth after the Opening Prayer to break open God's Word on their level. It is the Mass, the Liturgy of the Word for children. They, too, need the scriptures to know the Lord. So grateful to the parishioners who are serving as Catechists in leading the children. The CLOW children return during the offertory while the Young Disciples remain there until the end of Mass. Yasmine Rodriguez is our parish staff member who oversees the Sunday ministries for children.

The Family Mass is offered once a month and all families are invited to attend that Mass. Children sing, offer hospitality, proclaim the scripture readings, and serve at the altar. Please check the bulletin for the upcoming dates for Family Masses. Our children show the greatest courage in going before the community to serve, it helps their confidence and is a great model for others not to be afraid to come forward to serve.

There are so many great gifts that our children have to serve their community. And parents, we appreciate your witness in bringing your children to Mass. It is important to lay a great foundation that children are welcome in the House of God, and the goal is to be that witness to others. We may not be able to be attentive for the entire Mass, but take what we can, one message, one thought, and know that the results of bringing your children to Mass are long-term and not always seen in the present.

If Jesus loved children it makes sense all his followers should show love and patience with all the children who come to God's house. We support all you parents.

## *St. Vincent de Paul: A Lesson in Charity and Compassion*

This Friday, September 27, the Church celebrates the feast of St. Vincent de Paul. Born to a poor family in the southwest of France, Vincent showed his intellectual gifts from a young age, studying theology at the age of 15. He continued his studies and was eventually ordained a priest in 1600. Although Vincent had initially begun his priesthood with the intention of securing a life of leisure for himself, he underwent a change of heart after hearing the confession of a dying peasant. Moved with compassion for the poor, he began undertaking missions and founding institutions to help them both materially and spiritually. St. Vincent de Paul became known for his empathy, compassion, and his dedication to serving the poor. St. Vincent de Paul truly believed in the intrinsic value of every person. For this reason St. Vincent de Paul is known as the patron of Catholic charities.

To this day, the Society of St. Vincent de Paul continues his work and is dedicated to feeding, clothing, housing and healing individuals and families in our community who have nowhere else to turn for help. They also provide meaningful opportunities for volunteers to serve their neighbors in need with love and

compassion. St. Vincent de Paul also embodies the central message of our annual theme, **I will look twice, until I see Christ in you**, by showing every person the respect and dignity they deserve.


Following the example of St. Vincent de Paul, St. Patrick is founded on the pillar of social justice, always looking to serve the most vulnerable and accompany those in need. We have a number of ministries and resources available to those looking to get more involved in social justice and outreach. Ministries like Paz de Cristo, André House, Just Faith, Maggie's Place, prison ministry, food collection, and our emergency assistance program are just a few examples of how you can get involved. 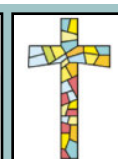

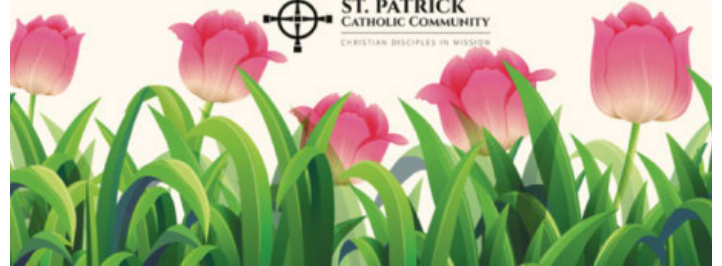

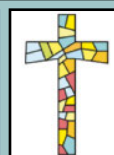

# Sacrament Preparation

The first step in registering for sacraments is to attend a Parent Orientation. Attend only once and there is no need to RSVP.

- Thursday, Sept. 26, 6:00 - 7:30 pm, Fenlon Hospitality Center
- Wednesday, Oct. 2, 6:00 - 7:30 pm, Daily Mass Chapel

Children do not need to attend the Orientation, but are most welcome to attend, if needed.



- In the Diocese of Phoenix, children typically prepare for Reconciliation in second grade and above, and First Communion and Confirmation in third grade and above.
- Preparation for Reconciliation must come prior to the Celebration of First Communion and Confirmation.
- All children must have concurrent enrollment in a Faith Formation program such as CGS (Atrium), Family Faith Formation, ROCK45, or attend a Diocesan Catholic School.

**Suicide claims more lives than war, murder, and natural disasters combined. It is the 10th leading cause of death in the U.S.**

**Many suicide loss survivors struggle with the outmoded belief that those who die by suicide are condemned to hell.**

**As Bishop Dolan of the Diocese of Phoenix writes: "The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us... we should not despair of the eternal salvation of persons who have taken their own lives."**

**Far less than 5% of suicide and substance loss survivors receive the support they need. Those left behind are often stigmatized, isolated, or forgotten. They can lose hope or sadly seek relief in the very thing that took their loved one.**

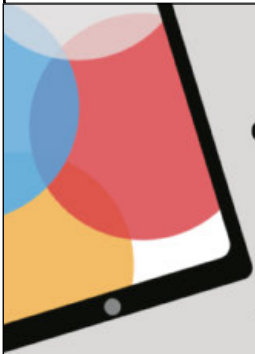

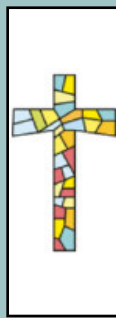
